Dear Sir or Madam,

A52 essential maintenance between Saxondale and Barrowby, Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire

I'm writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential resurfacing and drainage maintenance work on the A52 eastbound and westbound carriageways.

This work is part of a package of essential maintenance work on the A1, A52 and A46. We will be working along the routes in a phased and co-ordinated manner. Working now will prevent bigger problems in the future, which would require even more work and cause unplanned unnecessary disruption.

When will this work take place?

We plan to start this work on 29 January 2018 and will finish by 16 March 2018.

Please note that all our planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will it affect traffic?

We can carry out the drainage work using temporary traffic signals. To maintain a safe environment for our workers and customers, we'll need to fully close the carriageway to carry out the resurfacing work.

To minimise disruption, we will fully close the A52 between Barrowby and Elton overnight from 8pm to 6am. During these closures, we will put a fully signed diversion route in place through the A46 and A1.

We will also need two full weekend closures of the A52 around the A1 junction at Barrowby. The first planned weekend closure dates and times are Friday 16th February, full carriageway closure put in place at 8pm and lifted on Monday the 19th February at 6am. The second planned weekend closure dates and times are Friday 23rd February, full carriageway closure put in place at 8pm and lifted on Monday the 26th February at 6am.

We will maintain access to properties that can only be accessed from the A52. Where side roads are closed onto the A52, we expect that local traffic will find an alternate route.

We have been and will continue to work closely with key local stakeholders in the area, including local authorities and businesses. We are eager to work with you to maximise opportunities to minimise disruption. We are happy to facilitate any additional work such as litter picking and other maintenance activities you may wish to carry out during our proposed road closure.

Thank you for your patience while we carry out this vital work. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
