Progress since the last update

David has ben checking his finds and has forwarded a photo of a superb shard of Samian Ware he found in the spoil while filling in the "Large Trench". Hopefully we will be able to date this with degree of accuracy.

On the documentation front I have sourced a copy of a translation by Professor L. V. D. Owen of An Extent of Langar and Barnstone circa 1340. This is from the Thoroton Society Records Series Volume xi of 1945. Although there is no mention of St Ethelburga's it does give us names of the residents of the two villages along with field names etc.

Workshops - Autumn Term
