- > Before the Anglo-Saxons came, most people lived in separate farms scattered across the countryside. How did the Anglo-Saxons change this?

The Anglo-Saxon diet:

- > Which plants did the Anglo-Saxons grow? > Which wild plants did they collect?
- > Which animals did the Anglo-Saxons keep on their farms? > Which animals did they hunt?
