

# LANGAR CUM BARNSTONE PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held at Barnstone Village Hall, 7.30pm on  
Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2021

**1. Declarations of interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

**2. Apologies for absence**

Apologies were made for Cllrs. Barlow, Bellamy, Morris, Pulford & Clarke.

**3. Approval of minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021**

It was **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the above meeting, which were duly signed by the chairman.

**4. Matters for report (for information only)**

Dog bin on Cropwell Road has now been emptied.

**5. Public open session**

One member of the public was present

Member of public has a passion for WW2 history with a focus on the US Air Force and wishes to erect a memorial at the 207 Squadron RAF Langar Memorial for the US Air Force personnel who operated from here, including those for Operation Market Garden.

Cllr. Fry proposed to bring forward item 17. This was agreed.

It was **RESOLVED** that, assuming all of the 207 Squadron veterans were in agreement and the memorial will be erected on the same site, the member of public could go ahead with his proposal. It was further **RESOLVED** that he would liaise with the Parish Clerk on all action taken.

**6. Police reports**

Cllr. Fry advised that the parish are not receiving as many police updates as they were previously, including the report showing crime updates.

It was **RESOLVED** that Cllr. Combellack would look into this and ensure the Parish were on all the mailing lists.

**7. Borough & County Council reports**

Cllr. Combellack reported that, to help with carbon footprint, RBC are trialling trucks powered with vegetable oil.

Cllr. Purdue-Horan reported that he authorised the works for the drop down kerbs in Barnstone, which have now been completed.

Cllr. Bailey reported the following:

- Free trees are once again available for all residents in RBC and need to be applied for by the end of October.
- Streetwise are running a scheme where they will, with notice, provide all equipment and then collect all rubbish free of charge, should local groups wish to undertake litter-picking sessions.
- The work has started on RBC crematorium in Cotgrave.

**Cllr. Fry** reported that the proposed new Rushcliffe Borough Council wards would have the 10 new houses in Barnstone in Neville & Langar ward, with the rest of Barnstone in the new Aslockton & Cropwell ward. Cllr. Fry will transmit these concerns to the consultation.
